- 8 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.1 9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

God our Saviour, Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour

- KJV 1 Timothy 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope; (1 Tim. 1:1 KJV)
- 4 To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour. (Tit. 1:4 KJV)

Daniel 7:9-14

- 9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.
- 10 A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.
- 11 I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I
 beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the
 burning flame.
- 12 As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time.1
- 13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. (Dan. 7:9-13 KJV)

MAT. 1:21-25

- 21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.1
- 22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,
- 23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.1
- 24 Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:
- 25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS. (Matt. 1:21-25 KJV)

Ahaz

- KJV 2 Kings 16:1 In the seventeenth year of Pekah the son of Remaliah Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign.
- 2 Twenty years old was Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not that which was right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.
- 3 But he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, yea, and made his son to pass through the fire, according to the abominations of the heathen, whom the LORD cast out from before the children of Israel.
- 4 And he sacrificed and burnt incense in the high places, and on the hills, and under every green tree.
- (2 Ki. 16:1-4 KJV)

Isaiah 7:11-14

- 11 Ask thee a sign of the LORD thy God; ask it either in the depth, or in the height above.1
- 12 But Ahaz said, I will not ask, neither will I tempt the LORD.
- 13 And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; Is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also?
- 14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.1
- (Isa. 7:11-14 KJV)

Sign of the prophet Jonas

- 38 Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.
- 39 But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:
- 40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- 41 The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.
- 42 The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here.
- (Matt. 12:38-42 KJV)
