



Determinate counsel




ὀρίζω

- **19898 ὀρίζω** 1aor. ὤρισσα; pf. pass. ὤρισμαι; 1aor. pass. ὤρίσθην; (1) as setting a boundary; (a) of time *fix, appoint* (HE 4.7); (b) of space *fix, determine* (AC 17.26); (2) of persons *appoint, designate* (AC 17.31); (3) as making a definite plan *appoint, decide, determine* (LU 22.22)


Foreknowledge

- TBT 1 Peter 1:2 κατὰ πρόγνωσιν Θεοῦ πατρός, ἐν ἁγιασμῷ Πνεύματος, εἰς ὑπακοὴν καὶ ῥαντισμὸν αἵματος Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ· χάρις ὑμῖν καὶ εἰρήνη πληθυνθείη.
 - KJV 1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.



- **2945 πρόγνωση, εως, ή** advance knowledge, foreknowledge, what is known ahead of time



saying might be fulfilled

- TBT John 18:9 ἵνα **πληρωθῆ** ὁ λόγος ὃν εἶπεν ὅτι Οὓς δέδωκάς μοι, οὐκ ἀπώλεσα ἐξ αὐτῶν οὐδένα.
 - KJV John 18:9 That the saying **might be fulfilled**, which he spake, Of them which thou gavest me have I lost none.

πληρώω

- **22176 πληρώω** impf. ἐπλήρουν, pass. ἐπληρούμην; fut. πληρώσω; 1aor. ἐπλήρωσα; pf. πεπλήρωκα; pf. pass. πεπλήρωμαι; 1aor. pass. ἐπληρώθην; 1fut. pass. πληρωθήσομαι; (1) literally, with an idea of totality *make full, fill (up) completely* (AC 2.2); passive *become full, be filled with* (MT 13.48); figuratively, as filling something or someone with intangible things or qualities *fill* (MT 23.32; AC 5.28); mostly passive *be full of, become filled with*; (a) with the genitive of the thing (AC 13.52); (b) with the dative of the thing (LU 2.40); (c) with the accusative of the thing (PH 1.11); (d) absolutely *be well-supplied* (PH 4.18); (2) of a set span of time *complete, reach an end, fill (up)*; only passive in the NT *be fulfilled* (MK 1.15); (3) of foreknown laws, promises, prophecies, predictions, purposes *fulfill*; (a) active *bring to fulfillment, give true meaning to* (AC 3.18); (b) predominately passive *be fulfilled* (MT 1.22); (4) as fulfilling commandments, duties, demands; in the NT only with reference to the will of God *carry out, perform, accomplish* (CO 4.17); (5) as bringing an activity to completion *finish, bring to an end, complete* (LU 7.1; AC 12.25)

The saying of Jesus

- ^{TBT} **John 18:32** ἵνα ὁ λόγος τοῦ Ἰησοῦ **πληρωθῇ**, ὃν εἶπε, **σημαίνων** ποίω θανάτῳ ἤμελλεν ἀποθνήσκειν.
 - ^{KJV} **John 18:32** That the saying of Jesus **might be fulfilled**, which he spake, **signifying** what death he should die.

Scripture fulfilled

- ^{TBT} **John 19:24** εἶπον οὖν πρὸς ἀλλήλους, Μὴ σχίσωμεν αὐτόν, ἀλλὰ λάχωμεν περὶ αὐτοῦ, τίνος ἔσται· **ἵνα ἡ γραφή πληρωθῇ** ἣ λέγουσα, Διεμερίσαντο τὰ ἱμάτιά μου ἑαυτοῖς, καὶ ἐπὶ τὸν ἱματισμὸν μου ἔβαλον κλῆρον. **οἱ μὲν οὖν στρατιῶται ταῦτα ἐποίησαν.**
 - ^{KJV} **John 19:24** They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: **that the scripture might be fulfilled**, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. **These things therefore the soldiers did.**

- ^{TBT} **John 19:11** ἀπεκρίθη ὁ Ἰησοῦς, Οὐκ εἶχες ἐξουσίαν οὐδεμίαν κατ' ἐμοῦ, εἰ μὴ ἦν σοι δεδομένον ἄνωθεν· διὰ τοῦτο ὁ παραδιδούς μέ σοι μείζονα ἁμαρτίαν ἔχει.
 - ^{KJV} **John 19:11** Jesus answered, Thou couldst have no power *at all* against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.
