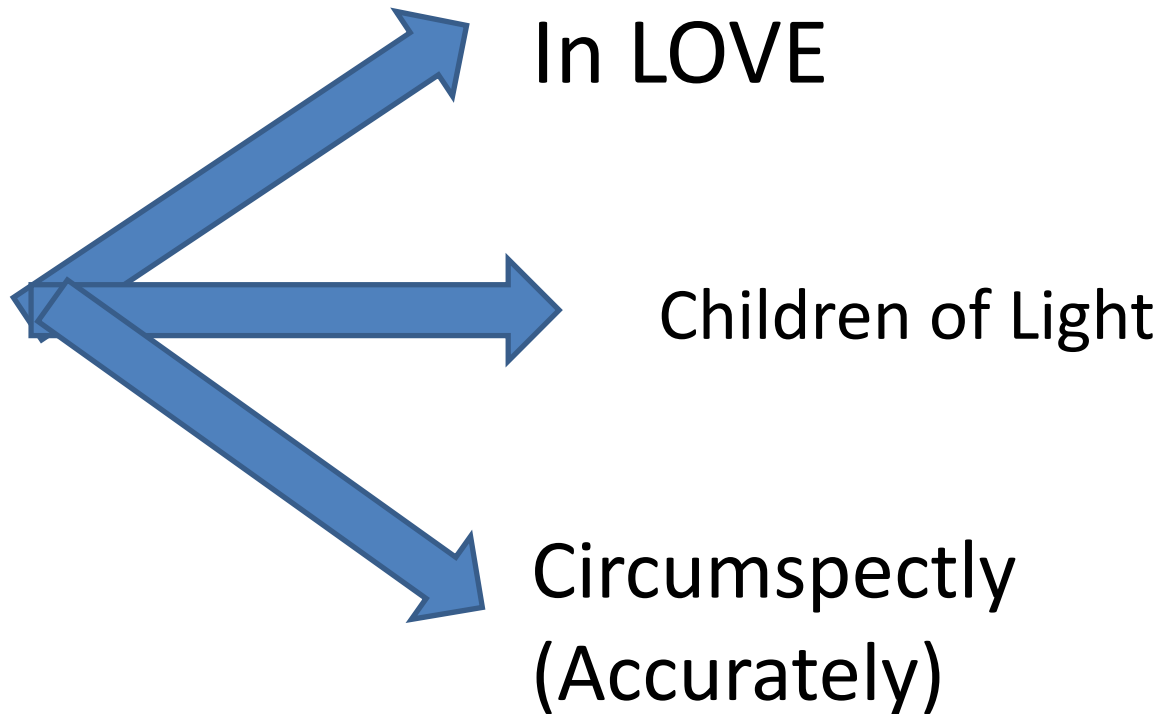
# ΠΕΡΙΠΑΤΕΩ

- Eph 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked <4043> according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- Eph 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk <4043> in them.
- Eph 4:1 I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk <4043> worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,
- Eph 4:17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk <4043> not as other Gentiles walk <4043>, in the vanity of their mind,
- Eph 5:2 **And walk <4043> in love**, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.
- Eph 5:8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: **walk <4043> as children of light:**
- Eph 5:15 See then that **ye walk <4043> circumspectly**, not as fools, but as wise,

- Eph.5:8 (AV) For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:
- **Eph.5:8 (TR) ητε γαρ ποτε σκοτος  
νυν δε φως εν κυριω ως τεκνα  
φωτος περιπατειτε**

# “will” in Ephesians (7X’s)

The Greek word **thelema**, meaning "will", occurs seven times in Ephesians, and forms the following outline:

**A | 1: 1. Apostle. By the will of God.**

**B | 1: 5. Adoption. Good pleasure of His will.**

**C | 1: 9. Secret of His will. Fullness of times.**

**D | 1: 11. The counsel of His own will.**

**C | 2: 3. Will of the flesh.--in time past.**

**B | 5: 17. Understanding what the will of the Lord is.**

**A | 6: 6. Servants of Christ. Doing the will of God.**

# Be filled with the Spirit

- Eph. 5:18 (AV) And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;
- **18 (TR) και μη μεθυσκεσθε οινω εν ω εστιν ασωτια αλλα πληρουσθε εν πνευματι**
- **Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.**
