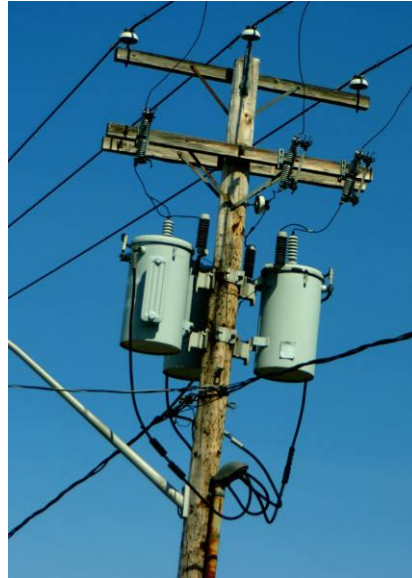

rod

- Heb 1:8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre <4464> of righteousness is the sceptre <4464> of thy kingdom.
- Heb 9:4 Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod <4464> that budded, and the tables of the covenant;
- Heb 11:21 By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, leaning upon the top of his staff <4464>.
- Re 2:27 And he shall rule them with a rod <4464> of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
- Re 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod <4464>: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.
- Re 12:5 And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod <4464> of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.
