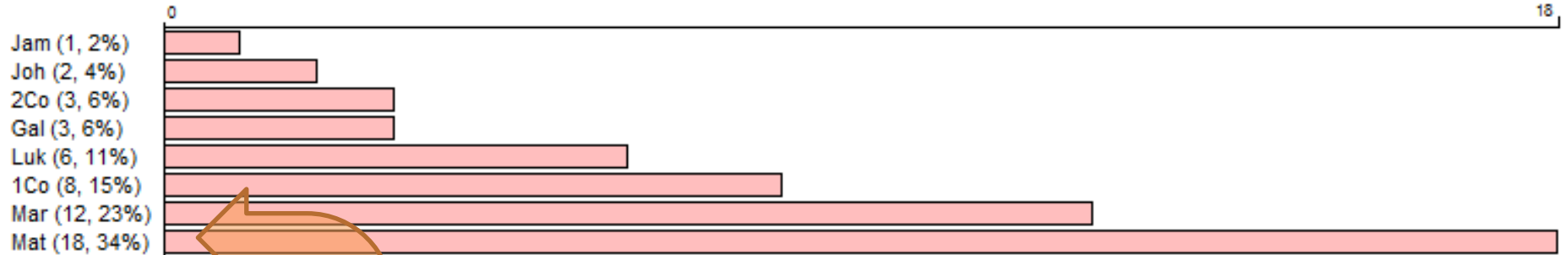

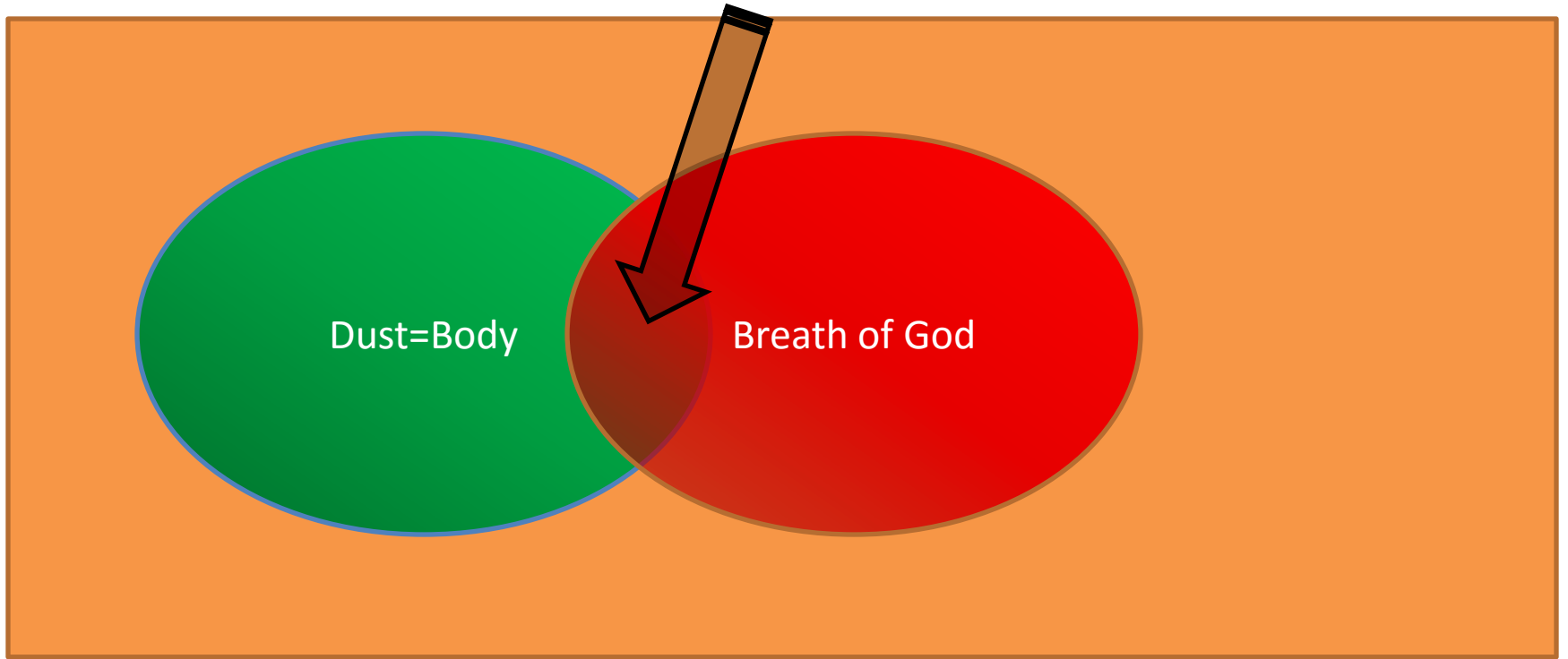
# Adam: Living Soul

# Soul=Breath of God + Body


