The "Four Days" in Scripture



Mans Day

Now

II Timothy 3:1-9
*I Corinthians 4:3

Man going his own way under Satan (a period of grace). Then, according to II Tim. 3:9, God interrupts and the Day of Christ is ushered in.

Events at the end of Man's Day overlap the beginning of the Day of Christ.

**Man's judgement = literal in the Greek "Man's Day"

Return of Elijah marks end of this Day and beginning of Day of Christ
Malachi 4:5-6



Day of Christ

Messiah's Day

Philippians 1:6-10
Philippians 2:16

Present believers await this Day of Christ.
True Israel awaits this Messiah's Day.
Malachi 3:16 - 4:6
Matthew 11:13-15; 17:11-13

Psalms 110:1
This day begins with Christ ruling from Heaven.
Acts 2:16-21
Amos 9:11; Hosea 3:4,5
Hosea 5:15 - 6:3
Isaiah 2:2-5
Zechariah. 8:13,23
Joel 2:27-32

Then a revolt against Messiah
Psalms 2; Joel 3
but revolt put down with Messiah's coming (parousia) to earth to continue His rule.



Day of the Lord

Jehovah's Day

Book of Revelation tells the events of this day.

Events at the close of Messiah's Day overlap the beginning of this Jehovah's Day.

Includes the "Tribulation"
II Thessalonians 2:1-12

Includes Messiah on earth:
2nd Coming
I Thessalonians 4

Includes the 1,000 year period called the Millenium, plus the "little season" and the "great white throne judgement"

3. TRANSITIONAL. The KINGDOM RE-OFFERED and AGAIN REJECTED.

God's Hidden Purpose (The Mystery) is revealed in the Epistles of Paul written after the Acts period:

Ephesians
Philippians
Colossians
Philemon
Titus
I Timothy
II Timothy

1. A SECRET which unveils God's Hidden Purpose (not the subject matter of Old Testament prophecy).
Ephesians 3:3,5,9
2. The KING EXHAULTED and made HEAD over all things to the Church, which is His Body, namely... THE SECRET.
3. Hence, in this parenthetical time, the KINGDOM of PROMISE is in ABEYANCE.
Hebrews 2:8
4. NO DISTINCTION between JEW and GENTILE.
Colossians 3:11

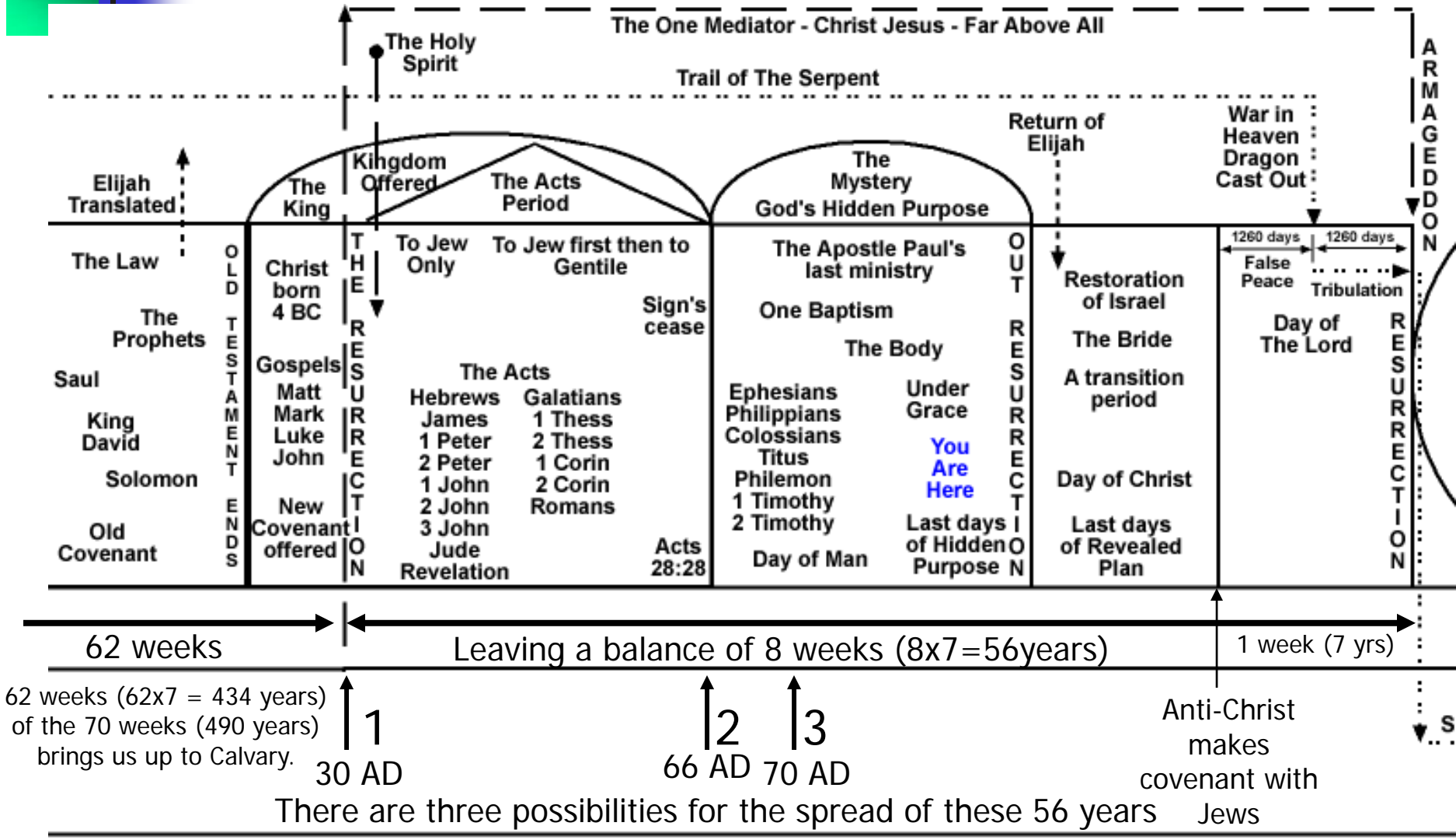

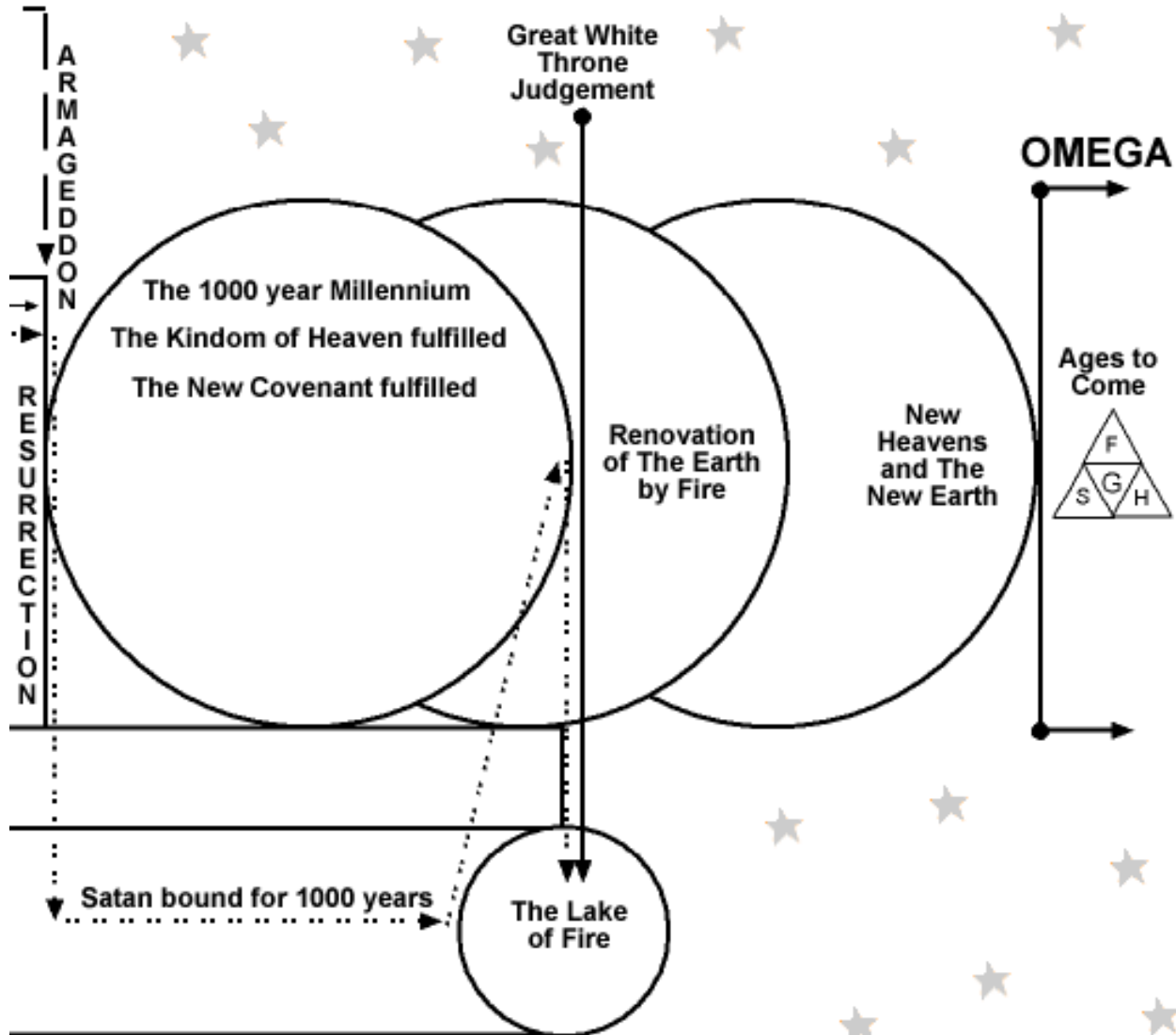

 - Day of God

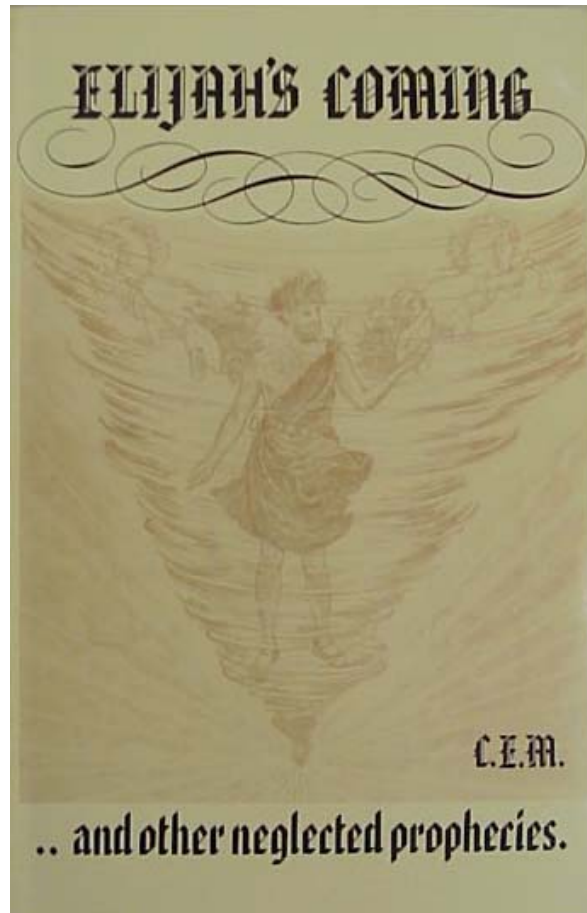

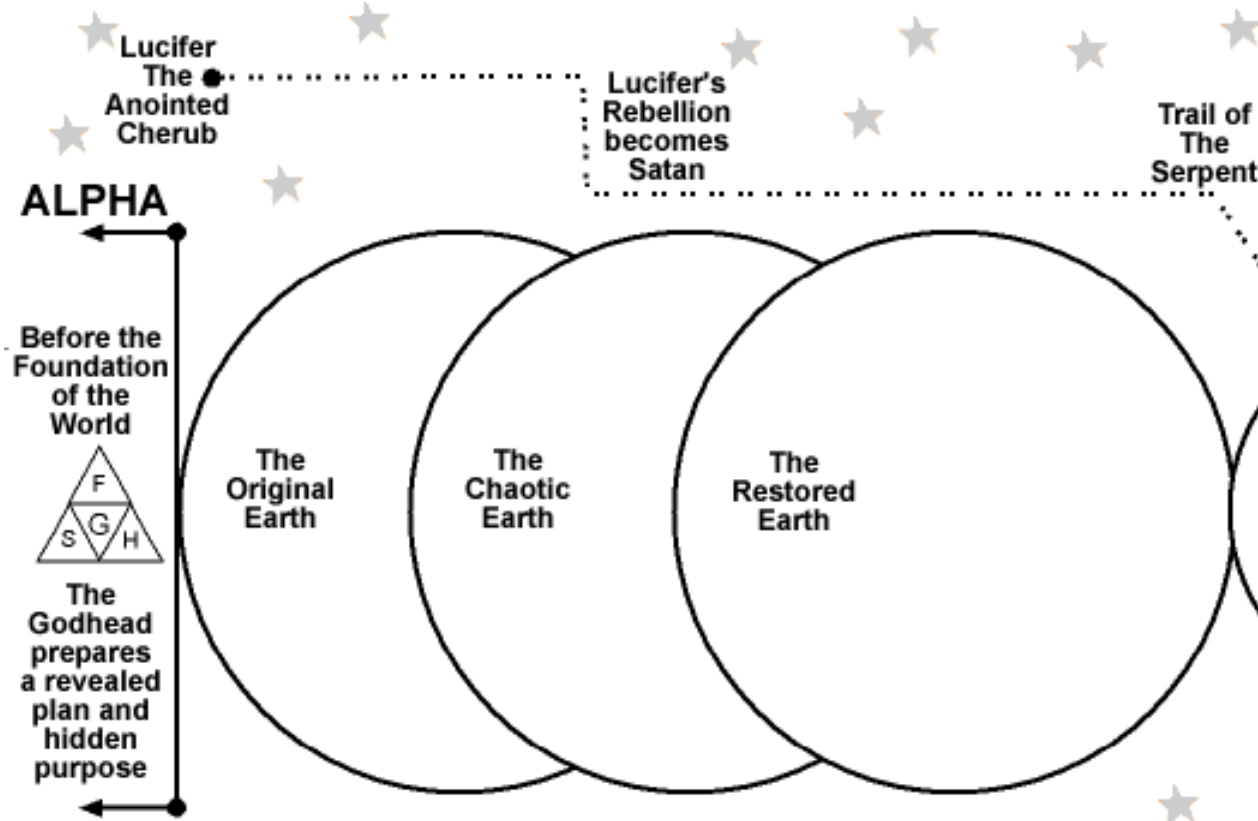


The content of this work is the result of some forty odd years of learning, unlearning and relearning the truths of the Divine library. Some other helps and hindrances are listed in the Bibliography.

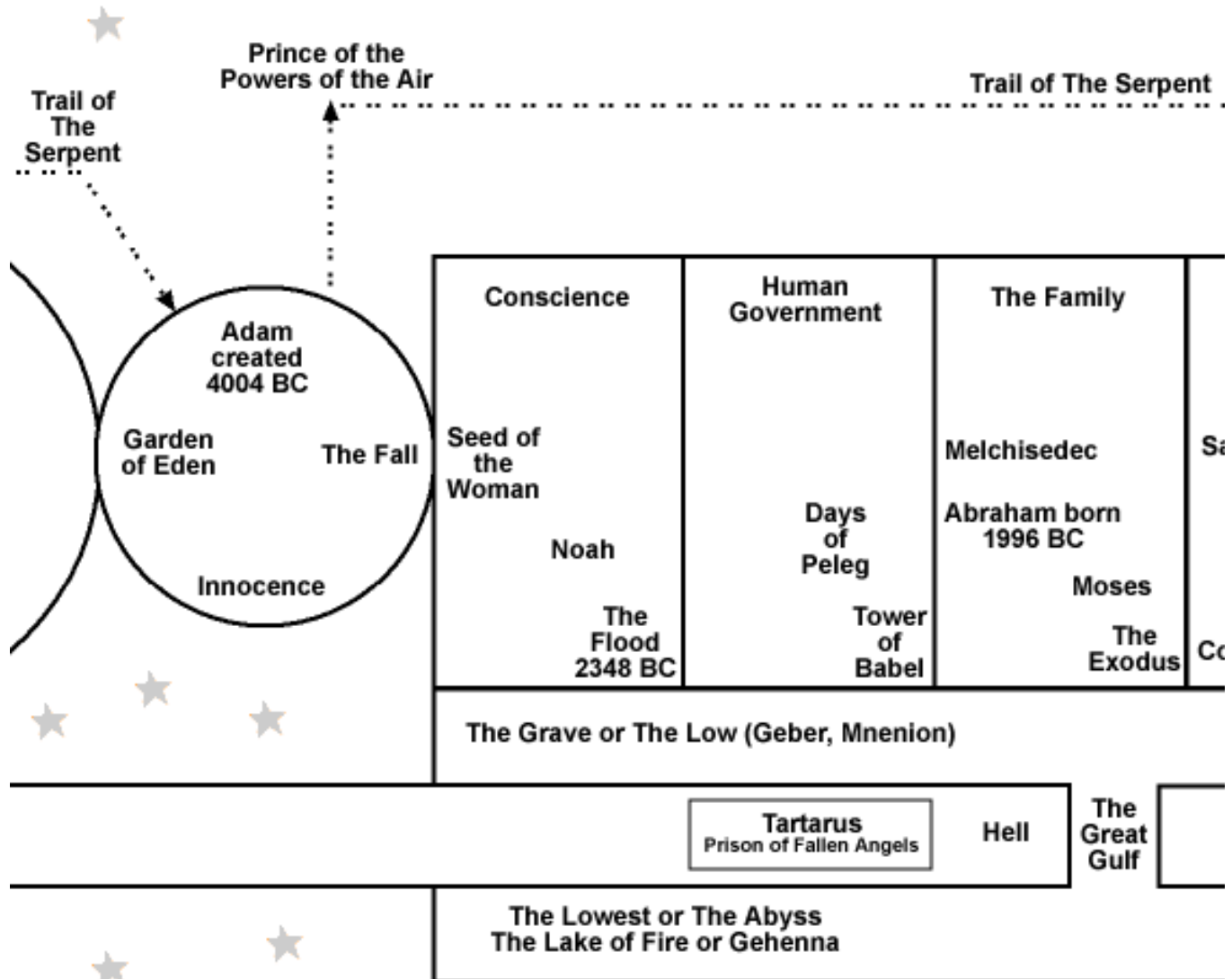

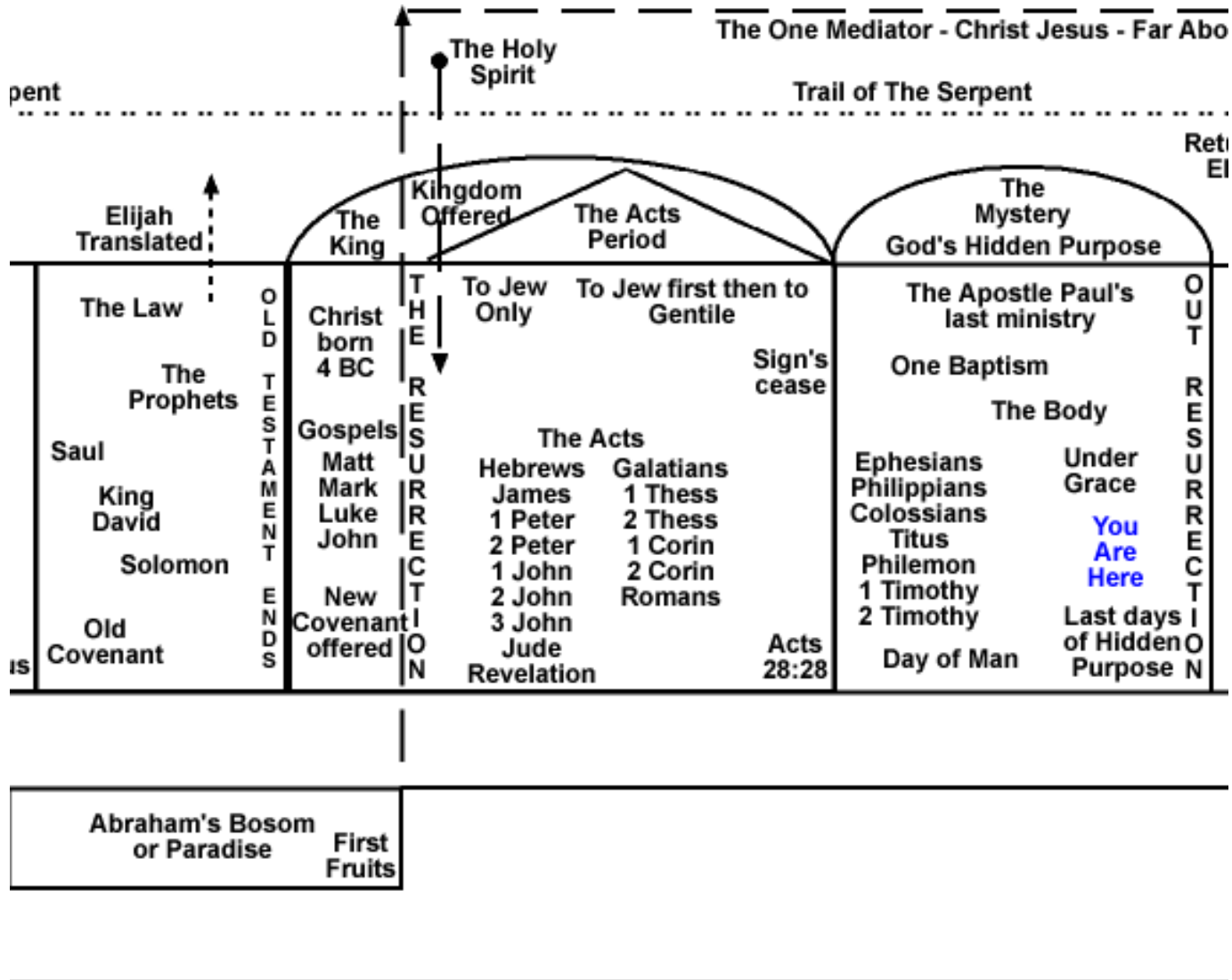
Overview of the Ages – Part 1



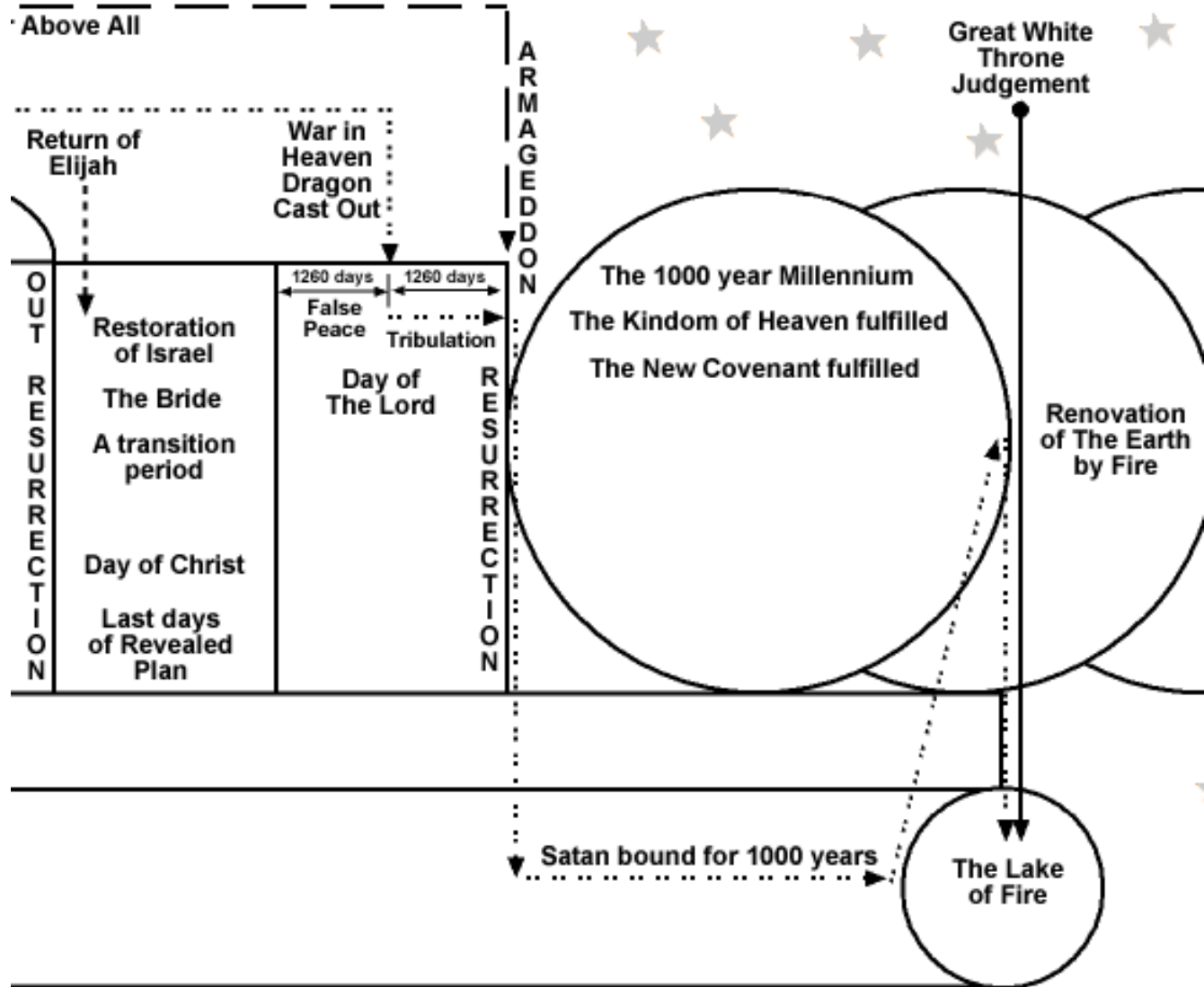
Overview of the Ages – Part 2



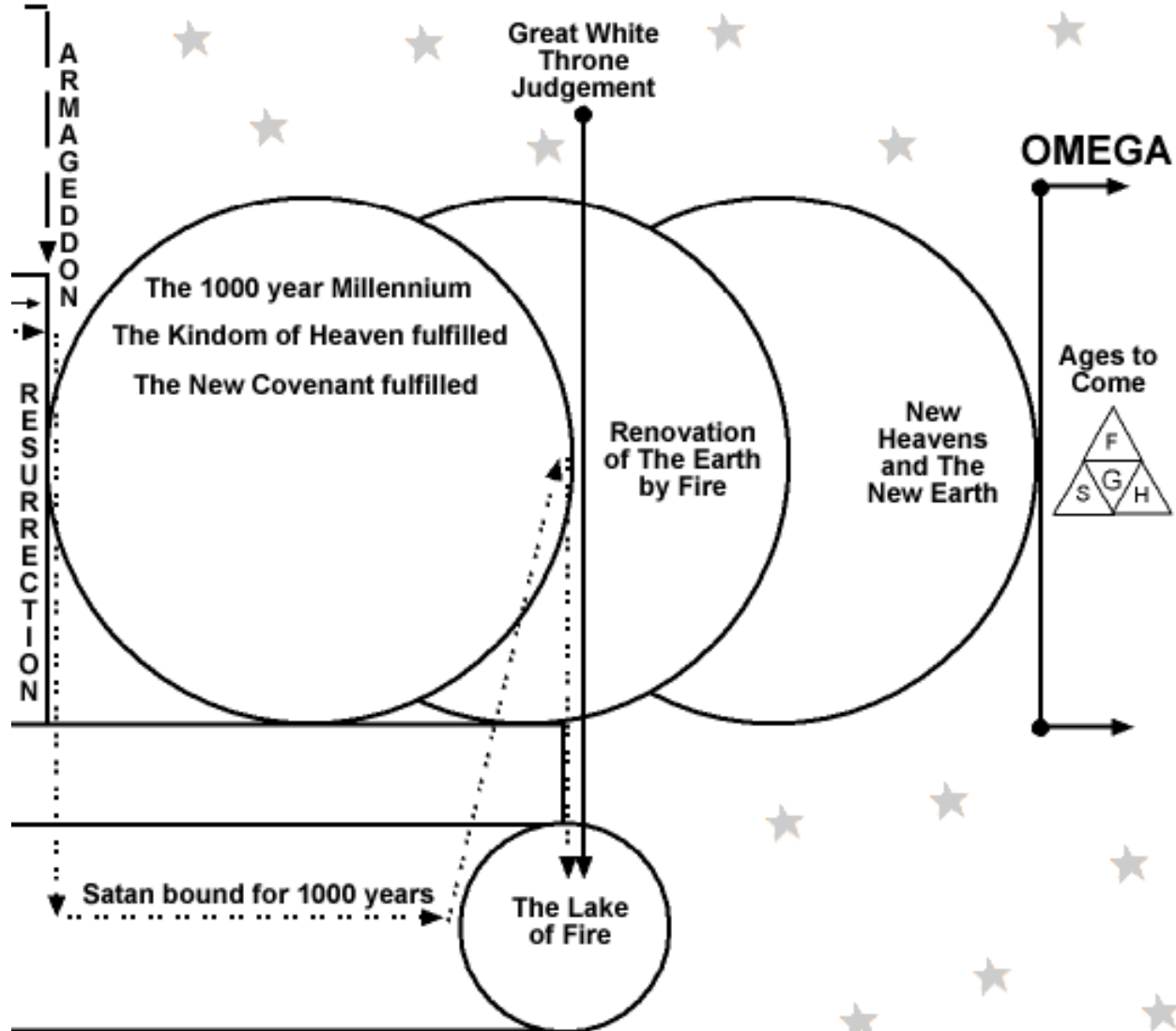
Overview of the Ages – Part 3

The Day of Christ - "Last Days" Part 6
The lesson on 11-25-2001 provides one more recap of the study series on the "Last Days" with an emphasis on clarifying the differences between the "Day of Christ" and the "Day of the Lord". There are four pre-eminent "Days" in scripture. Presently we live in the "Day of Man" which ends when Elijah returns and ushers in the "Day of Christ" which precedes the "Day of the Lord" ([to review the four days in scripture, click here](#)). The length of the "Day of Christ" is the time that leads up to the Day of the Lord. The final "day" in scripture is the "Day of God". Today, the members of the Body of Christ operate under the "Day of Man" and are called to perform good works that God has begun in each one of us. As Philippians 1:6 (KJV) states *"Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:"* These good works are to be performed until the "Day of Christ" when Elijah returns to restore Israel.
