

- <sup>3</sup> For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
- <sup>4</sup> For he spake in a certain place of the seventh *day* on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works. (Heb. 4:1-4 KJV)

- KJV Gen. 1:7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which *were* under the firmament from the waters which *were* above the firmament: and it was so.
- KJV Gen. 1:11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, *and* the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed *is* in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.
- KJV Gen. 1:12 And the earth brought forth grass, *and* herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed *was* in itself, after his kind: and God saw that *it* was good.



'asah' as found in the books of the Bible






# Compare!!

“The overthrow” cannot be future to this event.

- KJV Luke 11:50 That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;
- KJV Luke 11:51 **From the blood of Abel** unto the blood of Zacharias, which perished between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, It shall be required of this generation. (Lk. 11:51 KJV)
- TBT Luke 11:50 ἵνα ἐκζητηθῆ τὸ αἷμα πάντων τῶν προφητῶν τὸ ἐκχυνόμενον ἀπὸ καταβολῆς κόσμου ἀπὸ τῆς γενεᾶς ταύτης,

Angels were in charge. But NOT the inhabitable world to come.

- KJV Hebrews 2:5 For unto the angels hath he not put in subjection the world to come, whereof we speak.
