



KJV Heb. 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

KJV 1 Pet. 3:20 Which sometime were disobedient, **when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah,** while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

KJV 2 Pet. 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;


15 And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;  
16 As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.  
17 Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness.

μακροθυμία, ας, ἡ [μακροθυμέω] 'capacity for restraint in face of what is provocative' – α. in response to obnoxious acts or attitudes patience, forbearance – α. at the level of interpersonal relationships 2 Cor 6:6; Gal 5:22; Eph 4:2; Col 3:12; 2 Ti 3:10; 4:2. – β. at the level of relation between God or Christ and human beings Ro 2:4; 9:22; 1 Ti 1:16; 1 Pt 3:20; 2 Pt 3:15. – b. in response to discomfort or hardship patience Col 1:11; Hb 6:12; Js 5:10.

KJV 1 Peter 3:20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. 21 The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:






