

NOTES

It will be seen from page 17 in *The Companion Bible*, Genesis 11:20 - 25:1 that "THE GENERATIONS OF TERAH" are arranged in a *Repeated Alternation*, and that the Alternation there given is only so far as ABRAHAM is concerned. The *Histories* are divided up, and alternated with a brief summary of certain *Posterities*.

But the same principle of structure runs through not only the history of Terah, but also that of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. The sevenfold alternations may be presented as






Paul and Abraham

What associations do we find with Abraham?

KJV Heb. 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

KJV Heb. 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

KJV Heb. 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,

KJV Heb. 11:33 Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,




Abraham's faith is linked to promise

- Ps. 105:42; Acts 7:17; Rom. 4:13, 16; Gal. 3:14, 16, 18; Heb. 6:13; 7:6; 11:17
- KJV Ps. 105:42 For he remembered his holy promise, *and* Abraham his servant.
- KJV Acts 7:17 But when the time of the promise drew nigh, which God had sworn to Abraham, the people grew and multiplied in Egypt,
- KJV Rom. 4:13 For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, *was* not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.
- KJV Rom. 4:16 Therefore *it is* of faith, that *it might be* by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,
- KJV Gal. 3:14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
- KJV Gal. 3:16 Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.
- KJV Gal. 3:18 For if the inheritance *be* of the law, *it is* no more of promise: but God gave *it* to Abraham by promise.
- KJV Heb. 6:13 For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,
- KJV Heb. 7:6 But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises.
- KJV Heb. 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*,
