#### TRUE GRACE | ἡ χάρις καὶ ἡ ἀλήθεια (Jn. 1:17 ΤΒΤ)

Hendiadys

Hen-di'-a-dys; or, Two for One (Genesis 2:9. Ephesians 6:18). Two words used, but one thing meant.

Hen-di'-a-tris; or, Three for One
(Daniel 3:7). Three words used, but one thing meant.



# The temple "a type"

- KJV Heb. 8:5 Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, *that* thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount.
- KJV Heb. 9:23 *It was* therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.


The Wilderness Tabernacle

### He tabernacled among us





- KJV Romans 3:31 Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.






The law of commandments contained in ordinances
