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Review

“Justified” in Isaiah and Jeremiah

- Isa 43:9 Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, *It is truth*.
- Isa 43:26 Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.
- Isa 45:25 In the LORD shall all the seed of Israel be justified, and shall glory.
- Jer 3:11 And the LORD said unto me, The backsliding Israel hath justified herself more than treacherous Judah.

3466 μυστήριον *musterion moos-tay'-ree-on*

- 1) hidden thing, secret, mystery
 - 1a) generally mysteries, religious secrets, confided only to the initiated and not to ordinary mortals
 - 1b) a hidden or secret thing, not obvious to the understanding
 - 1c) a hidden purpose or counsel
 - 1c1) secret will
 - 1c1a) of men
 - 1c1b) of God: the secret counsels which govern God in dealing with the righteous, which are hidden from ungodly and wicked men but plain to the godly
- 2) in rabbinic writings, it denotes the mystic or hidden sense
 - 2a) of an OT saying
 - 2b) of an image or form seen in a vision
 - 2c) of a dream

First Occurrence

- Mt 13:11 He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries <3466> of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.

Example of an “Acts” useage

- 1Co 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery <3466>, *even the hidden wisdom*, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

Hid where? What was hidden?

- Eph 3:9 And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery <3466>, which from the beginning of the world hath been *hid in God*, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

What do these words mean?

συγ-κληρο-νομα - heirs together

και συσ-σωμα - body together

και συμ-μετοχα - partakers together

Today: συγκληρονόμος

- κληρονόμος, κληρονόμου, ὁ (κληῆρος, and νέμομαι, to possess), properly, *one who receives by lot*; hence, 1. *an heir* (in Greek writings from Plato down); ...
- 2. the idea of inheritance having disappeared, *one who has acquired or obtained the portion allotted him*: with the genitive of the thing, Heb. 6:17; 11:7;

συγκληρονόμος

- together + lot + possess == heirs together

σύν

κληῖρος

νέμομαι

κληρος, κλήρου, ὅ (lot)

- KJV Acts 1:26 And they gave forth their lots; and the lot fell upon Matthias; and he was numbered with the eleven apostles.

συγκληρονόμος

- KJV Romans 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.
- KJV Ephesians 3:6 That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:
- KJV Hebrews 11:9 By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as *in* a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:
- KJV 1 Peter 3:7 Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with *them* according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

Manifestation of truth, φανερόω

- Romans 1:19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed <5319> it unto them.
- Romans 3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested <5319>, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;
- Romans 16:26 But now is made manifest <5319>, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:

φαν stem

- 5318 φανερός adj, apparent, manifest
- 5319 φανερώω ν, to make manifest
- 5320 φανερώς adv, manifestly, plainly
- 5321 φανέρωσις η, f, manifestation
- 5322 φανός η, m, torch
- 5323 Φανουήλ η, m, “the face of God” - father of Anna
- 5324 φαντάζω ν, cause to appear
- 5325 φαντασία η, f, showy appearance
- 5326 φάντασμα η, η, an appearance

(2015) ἐπιφάνεια, ἐπιφανείας, ἡ

- KJV 2 Thessalonians 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- KJV 1 Timothy 6:14 That thou keep *this* commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- KJV 2 Timothy 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:
