

Summary of the mid-Acts - Acts 28 controversy

Sussoma - “the same body”

- Eph. 3:1 “For this cause” - takes us directly into Eph. 2
- Sussoma - better understood as “the body together” - Jew and Gentile
- Created not evolved
- No advantage to Israel
- No uncomely parts
- Head is Christ
- No signed gifts given

The body of Christ - an evolution?



The Church which is “his body” was created

κτίζω

- Romans 1:25 Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator <2936>, who is blessed for ever. Amen.
- 1 Corinthians 11:9 Neither was <2936> the man created <2936> for the woman; but the woman for the man.
- Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created <2936> in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
- Ephesians 2:15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make <2936> in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;
- Ephesians 3:9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created <2936> all things by Jesus Christ:
- Ephesians 4:24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created <2936> in righteousness and true holiness.
- Colossians 1:16 For by him were <2936> all things created <2936>, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created <2936> by him, and for him:
- Colossians 3:10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created <2936> him:
- 1 Timothy 4:3 Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created <2936> to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

Compare: Do you think PAul would confuse the sussoma with “the body of Christ”

- 28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers,
 - after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.
 - 29 Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles?
 - 30 Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?
 - 31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
 - 1 Cor 12:28-31

- 11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;
 - 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:
 - 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:
 - 14 That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;


If you are a part of “the body of Christ” --

 - Acts 26:22 Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come:
 - 23 (AV) That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.
