THE FIRST AMENDMENT

First Amendment


To the U. S. Constitution

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and petition the government for a redress of grievances.

THE SECOND AMENDMENT

The 2nd Amendment

A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed.



FROM EACH ACCORDING TO HIS ABILITY, TO EACH ACCORDING TO HIS NEEDS

- Usually attributed to Karl Marx
- Commonly used by socialists
- Some scholars trace the phrase to the New Testament.[12][13] In Acts of the Apostles the lifestyle of the community of believers in Jerusalem is described as communal (without individual possession), and uses the phrase "distribution was made unto every man according as he had need" (διεδίδετο δὲ ἑκάστῳ καθότι ἂν τις χρείαν εἶχεν):

ALL THINGS COMMON

- KJV Acts 2:44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common;
- KJV Acts 4:32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

SELECTIVE AND PRUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- KJV 1 Timothy 5:16 If any man or woman that believeth have widows, let them relieve them, and let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed. (1 Tim. 5:16 KJV)
