

# “No one”!!

- <sup>KJV</sup> **John 3:13** **And no man** hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, *even* the Son of man which is in heaven.
- <sup>TBT</sup> **John 3:13** **καὶ οὐδεὶς** ἀναβέβηκεν εἰς τὸν οὐρανόν, εἰ μὴ ὁ ἐκ τοῦ οὐρανοῦ καταβάς, ὁ υἱὸς τοῦ ἀνθρώπου ὁ ὢν ἐν τῷ οὐρανῷ.

# Immortality: [Fri] ἀθανασία, ας, ἡ immortality, endless existence, opposite τὸ θνητόν (*what is subject to death*)

- KJV 1 Cor. 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.
- KJV 1 Cor. 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
- KJV 1 Tim. 6:16 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom *be* honour and power everlasting. Amen.
- KJV 2 Tim. 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:
- TBT 1 Cor. 15:53 δεῖ γὰρ τὸ φθαρτὸν τοῦτο ἐνδύσασθαι ἀφθαρσίαν, καὶ τὸ θνητὸν τοῦτο ἐνδύσασθαι **ἀθανασίαν**.
- TBT 1 Cor. 15:54 ὅταν δὲ τὸ φθαρτὸν τοῦτο ἐνδύσῃται ἀφθαρσίαν, καὶ τὸ θνητὸν τοῦτο ἐνδύσῃται **ἀθανασίαν**, τότε γενήσεται ὁ λόγος ὁ γεγραμμένος, Κατεπόθη ὁ θάνατος εἰς νίκος.
- TBT 1 Tim. 6:16 ὁ μόνος ἔχων **ἀθανασίαν**, φῶς οἰκῶν ἀπρόσιτον, ὃν εἶδεν οὐδεὶς ἀνθρώπων, οὐδὲ ἰδεῖν δύναται· ὧ τιμὴ καὶ κράτος αἰώνιον. ἀμήν.
- TBT 2 Tim. 1:10 φανερωθεῖσαν δὲ νῦν διὰ τῆς ἐπιφανείας τοῦ σωτῆρος ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ, καταργήσαντος μὲν τὸν θάνατον, φωτίσαντος δὲ ζωὴν καὶ ἀφθαρσίαν διὰ τοῦ εὐαγγελίου,

# He descended and ascended

- <sup>KJV</sup> **Ephesians 4:10** He that **descended** is the same also that **ascended** up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)
- <sup>TBT</sup> **Ephesians 4:10** ὁ **καταβάς**, αὐτός ἐστι καὶ ὁ **ἀναβάς** ὑπεράνω πάντων τῶν οὐρανῶν, ἵνα πληρώσῃ τὰ πάντα.)

# David has not ascended


- <sup>KJV</sup> **Acts 2:34** For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,
- <sup>TBT</sup> **Acts 2:34** οὐ γὰρ Δαβὶδ ἀνέβη εἰς τοὺς οὐρανοὺς, λέγει δὲ αὐτός, Εἶπεν ὁ Κύριος τῷ Κυρίῳ μου, Κάθου ἐκ δεξιῶν μου,

# Nature of Mankind

- <sup>17</sup> I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous and the wicked: for *there is* a time there for every purpose and for every work.
- <sup>18</sup> I said in mine heart concerning the estate of the sons of men, that God might manifest them, and that they might see that they themselves are beasts.
- <sup>19</sup> For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, they have all one breath; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all *is* vanity.
- <sup>20</sup> All go unto one place; all are of the dust, and all turn to dust again.
- <sup>21</sup> Who knoweth the spirit of man that goeth upward, and the spirit of the beast that goeth downward to the earth? (Eccl. 3:17-21 KJV)

# The dead know not any thing!

- KJV Ecclesiastes 9:5 For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten. (Eccl. 9:5 KJV)



No work, no device, no knowledge,  
no wisdom in the grave.

- KJV Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest. (Eccl. 9:10 KJV)

# No remembrance in death

- KJV Psalm 6:5 For in death there is no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks?

# The dead are unaware

- KJV Job 14:21 His sons come to honour, and he knoweth it not; and they are brought low, but he perceiveth it not of them. (Job 14:21 KJV)

# They ... cannot hope for thy truth

- KJV Isaiah 38:18 For the grave cannot praise thee, death can not celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy truth.

# The dead praise not the LORD

- KJV Psalm 115:17 The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence.

# In that very day his thoughts perish!

- KJV Psalm 146:4 His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish. (Ps. 146:4 KJV)


# The land of forgetfulness

- KJV Psalm 88:10 Wilt thou shew wonders to the dead? shall the dead arise and praise thee? Selah.
- 11 Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? or thy faithfulness in destruction?
- 12 Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? and thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness? (Ps. 88:10-12 KJV)

Shall be turned! =“Return”

- KJV Psalm 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God. (Ps. 9:17 KJV)

- 2 Sam. 22:6; Job 11:8; Ps. 9:17; 16:10; 18:5; 55:15; 116:3; 139:8; Prov. 5:5; 7:27; 9:18; 15:24; 23:14; Isa. 5:14; 14:15; 28:15, 18; 57:9; Ezek. 31:16-17; 32:21, 27; Amos 9:2; Jon. 2:2; Hab. 2:5

# Sheol translated “Grave” (30Xs)

- Gen. 37:35; 42:38; 44:29, 31; 1 Sam. 2:6; 1 Ki. 2:6, 9; Job 7:9; 14:13; 17:13; 21:13; 24:19; Ps. 6:5; 30:3; 31:17; 49:14-15; 88:3; 89:48; Prov. 1:12; 30:16; Eccl. 9:10; Cant. 8:6; Isa. 14:11; 38:10, 18; Ezek. 31:15; Hos. 13:14
- KJV Genesis 37:35 And all his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted; and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him. (Gen. 37:35 KJV)
