
Certain others

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:1** Now upon the first *day* of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and **certain others** with them.
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:1** τῆ δὲ μιᾷ τῶν σαββάτων, ὄρθρου βαθέος, ἦλθον ἐπὶ τὸ μνήμα, φέρουσαι ἃ ἠτοιμάσαν ἀρώματα, καὶ **ΤΙΝΕΣ** σὺν αὐταῖς.




Stone rolled away

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:2** And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre.
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:2** εὑρον δὲ τὸν λίθον ἀποκεκυλισμένον ἀπὸ τοῦ μνημείου.



Much Perplexed

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:4** And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:4** καὶ ἐγένετο ἐν τῷ διαπορεῖσθαι αὐτὰς περὶ τούτου, καὶ ἰδοὺ, δύο ἄνδρες ἐπέστησαν αὐταῖς ἐν ἐσθήσεσιν ἀστραπτούσαις·



Told these things

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:10** It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary *the mother* of James, and other women that were with them, **which told these things unto the apostles.**
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:10** ἦσαν δὲ ἡ Μαγδαληνὴ Μαρία καὶ Ἰωάννα καὶ Μαρία Ἰακώβου, καὶ αἱ λοιπαὶ σὺν αὐταῖς, **αἱ ἔλεγον πρὸς τοὺς ἀποστόλους ταῦτα.**

Two of them

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:13** And, behold, **two of them** went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs.
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:13** Καὶ ἰδοὺ, **δύο ἐξ αὐτῶν** ἦσαν πορευόμενοι ἐν αὐτῇ τῇ ἡμέρᾳ εἰς κώμην ἀπέχουσαν σταδίους ἐξήκοντα ἀπὸ Ἱερουσαλήμ, ἧ ὄνομα Ἐμμαούς.

One of them

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:18** And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:18** ἀποκριθεὶς δὲ ὁ εἷς, ᾧ ὄνομα Κλεόπας, εἶπε πρὸς αὐτόν, Σὺ μόνος παροικεῖς ἐν Ἱερουσαλήμ, καὶ οὐκ ἔγνωσ τὰ γενόμενα ἐν αὐτῇ ἐν ταῖς ἡμέραις ταύταις;

Prophet, mighty in deed and word

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:19** And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which **was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:**
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:19** καὶ εἶπεν αὐτοῖς, Ποῖα; οἱ δὲ εἶπον αὐτῷ, Τὰ περὶ Ἰησοῦ τοῦ Ναζωραίου, ὃς **ἐγένετο ἀνὴρ προφήτης δυνατὸς ἐν ἔργῳ καὶ λόγῳ ἐναντίον τοῦ Θεοῦ καὶ παντὸς τοῦ λαοῦ·**

But we trusted

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:21** But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done.
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:21** ἡμεῖς δὲ ἠλπίζομεν ὅτι αὐτός ἐστιν ὁ μέλλων λυτροῦσθαι τὸν Ἰσραὴλ. ἀλλὰ γε σὺν πᾶσι τούτοις τρίτην ταύτην ἡμέραν ἄγει σήμερον ἀφ' οὗ ταῦτα ἐγένετο.

O fools and slow of heart

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Luke 24:25** Then he said unto them, **O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:**
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Luke 24:25** καὶ αὐτὸς εἶπε πρὸς αὐτούς, **ᾧ ἀνόητοι καὶ βραδεῖς τῇ καρδίᾳ τοῦ πιστεύειν ἐπὶ πᾶσιν οἷς ἐλάλησαν οἱ προφῆται·**

Lessons learnt

- ▶ 1. There are those who “look” on and get involved some perhaps do not
- ▶ 2. God will often leave strong pointers and witness – 2 men, and even himself.
- ▶ 3. We should never be so foolish as to not believe all that has been spoken by the prophets otherwise we will miss God's greater purpose.
