Introduction

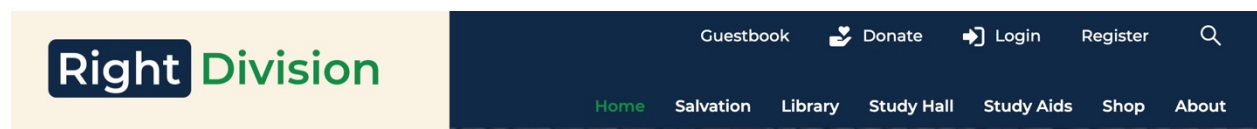
This user guide was developed to help our students navigate and use the fourth revision of RightDivision.com

Version 4 Goals

The revision of Right Division website revision became a project after several goals were approved by the Right Division, Inc. Board. These goals were:

- Improve on the study theme motivation from the verse 2 Timothy 2:15 “Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”
- Introduce new content or “milk” for those who aren’t saved or just became saved inspired by 2 Timothy 3:15 “And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.”
- Continue to provide access to meaty content for Christians who want to grow in the word, rightly divided from an Acts 28 perspective and migrate from Drupal to WordPress for the content management system (CMS)
- Lay the foundation for teaching Right Division principles from an online University perspective
 - Creating a profile so you may track your studies and lessons
 - Creating Comprehension Tests so you may check your understanding of right division on key doctrines in scripture
 - Improve on Study Aids with the addition of FAQ/help documentation

With these goals in mind, RightDivision.com has been through its fourth revision to deliver on these goals. The new menu looks like this below:

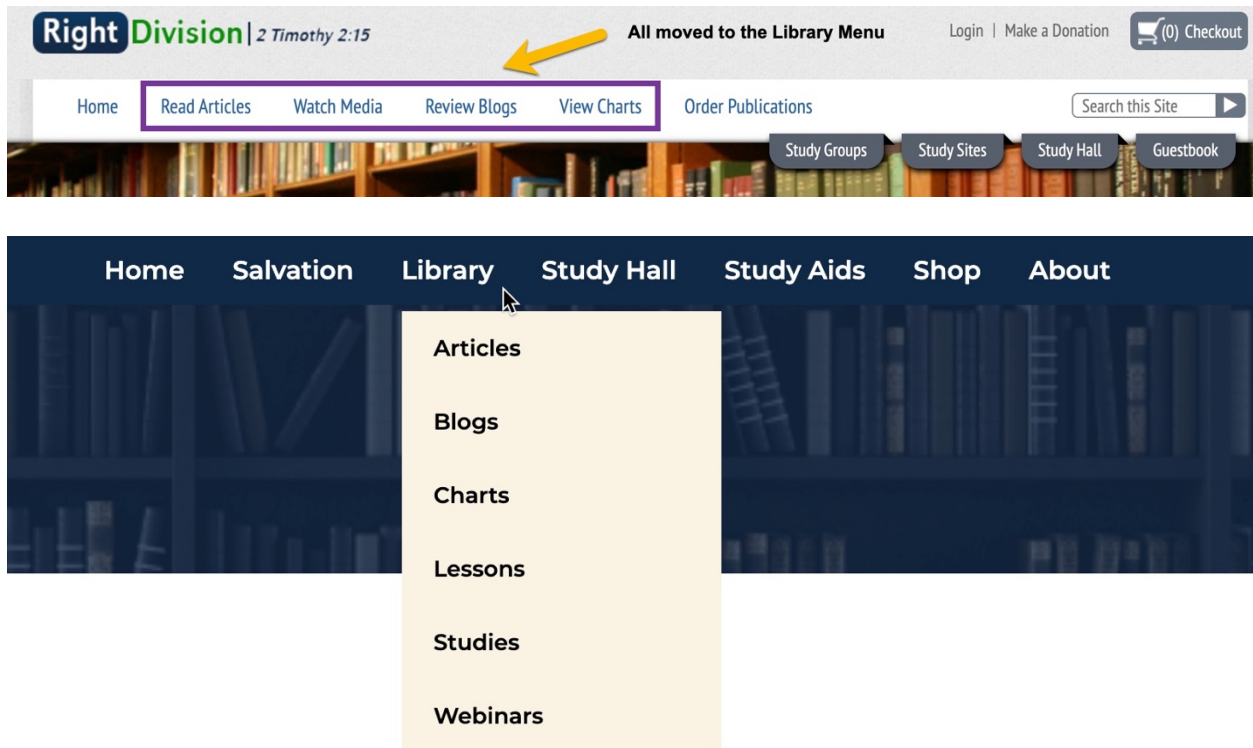


It consists of an upper and lower main menu that has organized content for our students to study. This document will walk you through these changes starting with the lower main menu.

Library Menu

This improvement has organized our content in new ways. From the home page, the new menu navigation has moved Articles, Studies, Lessons, Blogs and Charts from the main menu to be the majority of the library menu.




All these content types may be viewed from the Library menu. The new category of Webinars is listed here but those will become important later this year or early next as we hold virtual Right Division webinars.

Articles are written content from teachers on their topic of choice. It is usually in support of a lesson within a study. They may be reviewed by teacher.

Blogs are single messages posted on a single topic. Right Division has a rich history of Blogs provided by Leland Maples of the LOOPs ministries. You may filter blogs by teacher and topic as well.

The **Charts** section in the library is where you will find study aids that are visually driven. It is anchored by the largest chart “An Overview of God’s Revealed Plan and Hidden Purpose in the Ages”. This is a point and click navigation through the Bible.

Lessons on this site are usually attached to a Study. Each study published will have lessons added until the study is concluded. A lesson without a study parent is considered a one-off




message. On this lessons page you may sort and search on lessons by teacher and dates. Keep in mind, many of our lessons are power packed with content so each one may have topics that you are wanting to review.

You will be able to filter lessons date, alphabetically and by teacher.

Studies is where you will find most of the content on Right Division. There are over 82 studies on Right Division. A Study is the parent of its associated audio and video lessons which number over 1000. Northside Bible Church Founding Paster Clifford McLain has 30 Studies filled with 299 audio lessons going back to 1871. Following McLain was the teacher Derek McCammon who has 33 studies with over 365 audio lessons. After McCammon came our present teacher Wayne Stewart who is on his 19th study. We were able to transition to video support with Wayne. In the 19 studies he has taught so far, the contain 357 video and audio lessons.

You will be able to filter studies by Study Title and Teacher.

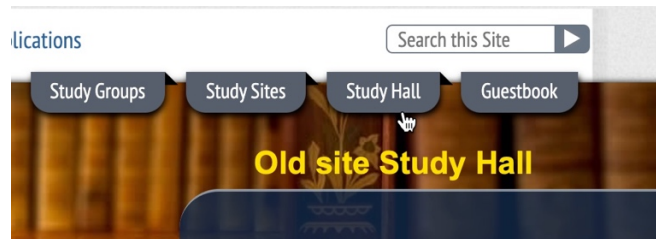

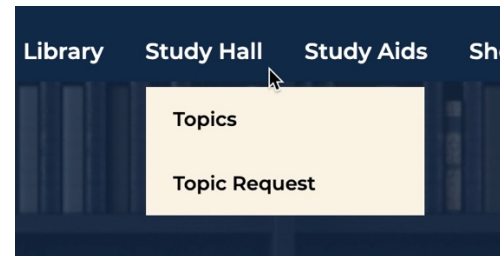
Study Hall Menu

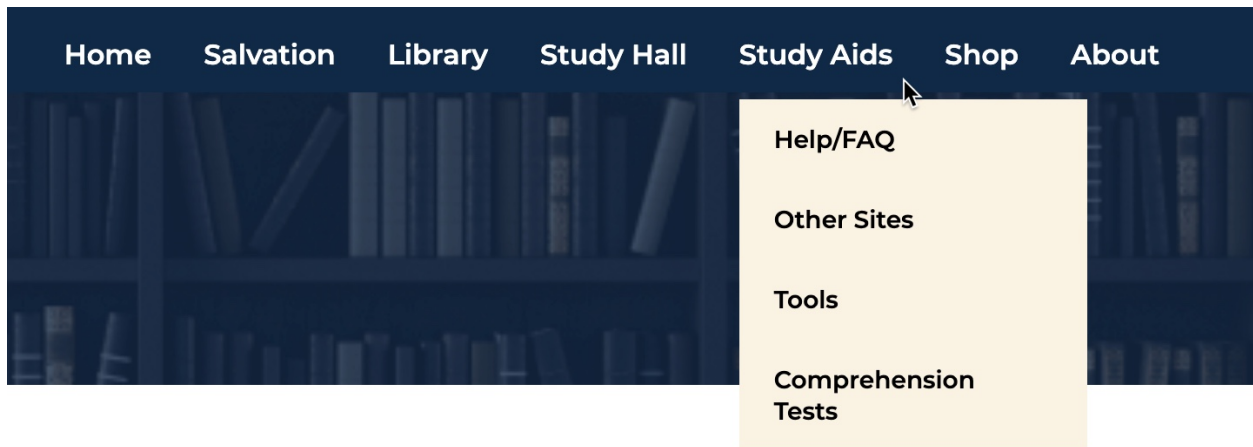

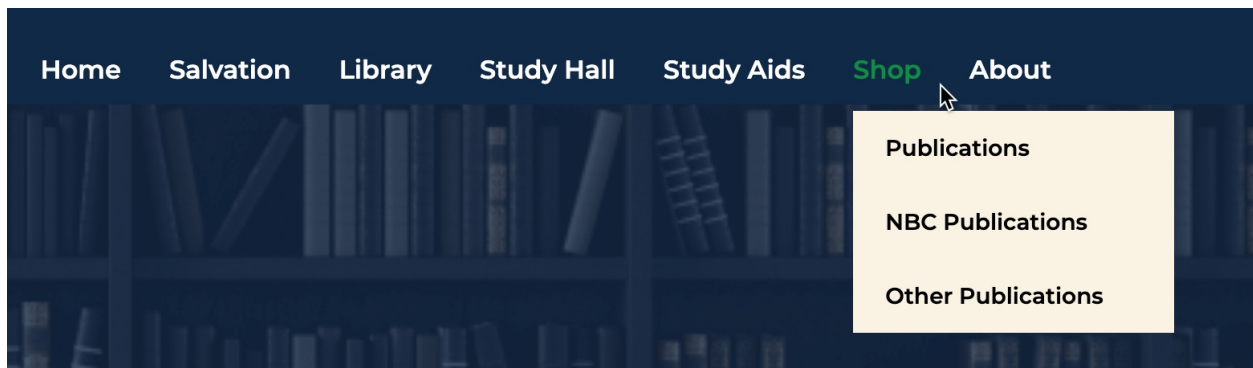

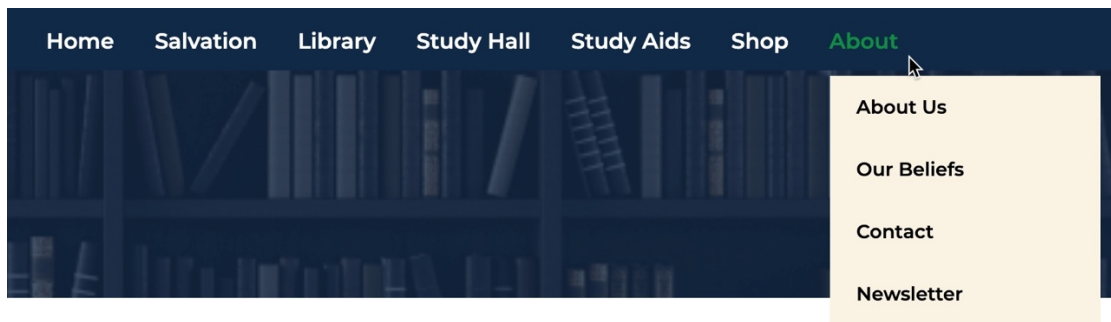

About Us is an overview of Right Division, Inc. which leads right into the next subject regarding what we believe and what it means to be an Acts 28 site.

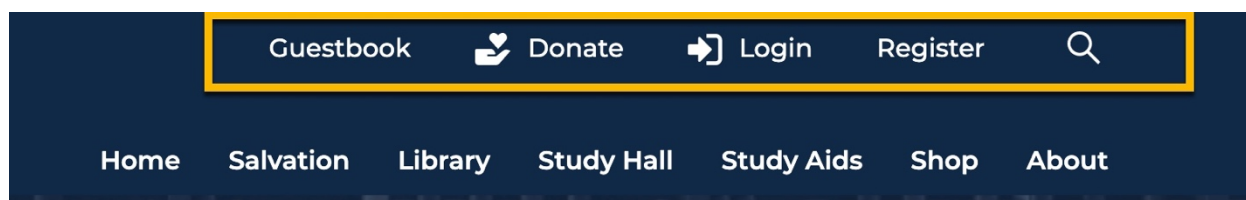
Our Beliefs page list what we believe and what it means to be an Acts 28 site with content teaching the principles of right division.

There is a new upper menu on the revised site.

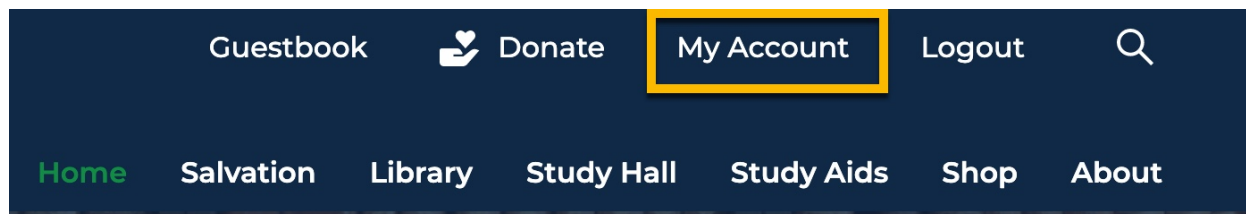

Accessibility Features

The entire website can use new the new accessibility feature for viewers that need assistance in reading web pages.



On every page you will see the green circle with a stick man waiting to assist you. If you click on the green button, you are presented an accessibility menu of options for enhancing the web page.

Contrast option provides you four ways of converting the contrast on your web page. Invert Colors, Dark Contrast, Light Contrast, or Desaturate. Try each one to see how it looks. Once you find one you like you may stay with it.

Highlight Links option does just that. It highlights links on your page, so they stick out visually.

Bigger Text option lets you control the size of your fonts on the pages. It adjusts the default setting to your preference. There are four increases available to increase your font sizes.

Text Spacing allows you to control the spacing on your web pages. The options are Light Spacing, Moderate Spacing, and Heavy Spacing.

Pause Animations option will pause animations on your web page.

Dyslexia Friendly option lets you choose between Dyslexia Font, which is a typeface for people with dyslexia, or Legible Fonts.

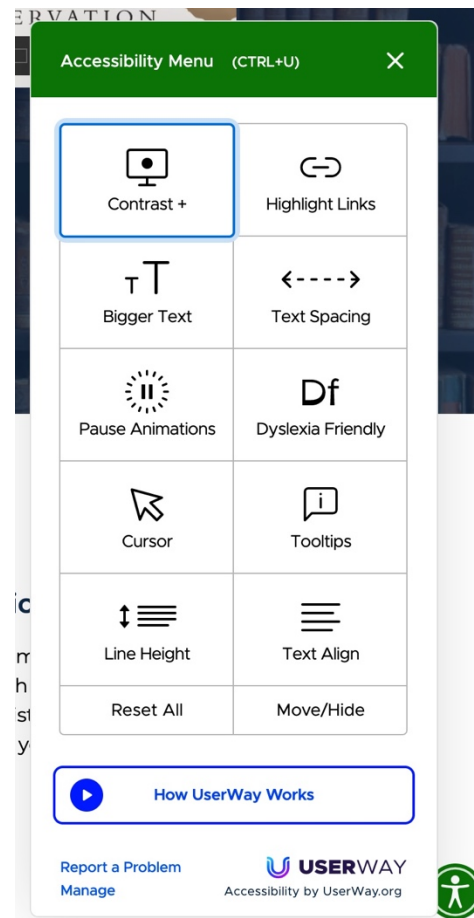
Cursor option allows you to change your cursor to Big, Add a Reading Mask or a Reading Guide.

Tooltips will turn on pop tips for any tools that have them.

Line Height will let you increase spacing 1.5x, 1.75x, or 2.0x.

Text Align option will let you align text left, right, center, or full justify.

There is a Reset All button and Move/Hide option.
