

# LIVETH, WAS DEAD, ALIVE FOREVERMORE -- KEYS

- Rom.14:9
- Rom. 6:9

14:9 For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.

9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.


# THINGS: SEEN, ARE, HEREAFTER

# WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- ◉ KJV **Revelation 1:19** Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, **and** the things which shall be hereafter;
- ◉ TBT **Revelation 1:19** γράψον ἃ εἶδες, καὶ ἃ εἰσι, **καὶ** ἃ μέλλει γίνεσθαι μετὰ ταῦτα.
- ◉ **Write the things thou hast seen and what they signify even the things which will come to pass afterward.**

# INTERPRETATION



## ○ Write things

- Seen
- Are (What they mean, signify)
- And/Even : The things which happen in the future

Some will take 4:1 to be the fulfilling of the future 1:19


# EXAMPLE FOLLOWS






# END OF THE ETERNITY? OR AGE?





- ◉ TBT Matthew 25:46 καὶ ἀπελεύσονται οὗτοι εἰς κόλασιν αἰώνιον· οἱ δὲ δίκαιοι εἰς ζωὴν αἰώνιον.

# EVERLASTING DESTRUCTION

- KJV **2 Thessalonians 1:9** Who shall be punished with **everlasting destruction** from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;
  
- <sup>TBT</sup> **2 Thessalonians 1:9** οἵτινες δίκην τίσουσιν, **ὅλεθρον αἰώνιον** ἀπὸ προσώπου τοῦ Κυρίου καὶ ἀπὸ τῆς δόξης τῆς ἰσχύος αὐτοῦ,

# ETERNAL JUDGMENT

- ◉ KJV **Hebrews 6:2** Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of **eternal judgment.**
- ◉ TBT **Hebrews 6:2** Βαπτισμῶν διδαχῆς,  
ἐπιθέσεώς τε χειρῶν, ἀναστάσεώς τε  
νεκρῶν, **καὶ κρίματος αἰωνίου.**

# ETERNAL REDEMPTION

- ◉ KJV **Hebrews 9:12** Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained **eternal redemption for us.**
- ◉ TBT **Hebrews 9:12** οὐδὲ δι' αἵματος τράγων καὶ μόσχων, διὰ δὲ τοῦ ἴδιου αἵματος εἰσῆλθεν ἐφάπαξ εἰς τὰ ἄγια, **αἰωνίαν λύτρωσιν** εύράμενος.

- ⦿ (Matthew 25:46 KJV) And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- ⦿ (Romans 16:25 KJV) Now to him that is of power to establish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,
- ⦿ (2 Corinthians 4:17 KJV) For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;
- ⦿ (2 Thessalonians 1:9 KJV) Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;
- ⦿ (2 Thessalonians 2:16 KJV) Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,
- ⦿ (1 Timothy 6:16 KJV) Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.
- ⦿ (2 Timothy 1:9 KJV) Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,
- ⦿ (2 Timothy 2:10 KJV) Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
- ⦿ (Titus 1:2 KJV) In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

- ◉ (Hebrews 5:9 KJV) And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;
- ◉ (Hebrews 6:2 KJV) Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.
- ◉ (Hebrews 9:14 KJV) How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
- ◉ (Hebrews 13:20 KJV) Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,
- ◉ (Jude 1:7 KJV) Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.
- ◉ (Revelation 14:6 KJV) And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,
