



B | -8-11. The saying of the living ones and elders.--Creation.

A | 5: 1-7. The throne, book, Lion, Lamb.

B | 8-14. The song of the living ones and elders.

The saying of angels.--Redemption.

FIRST OCCURRENCE

- ^{KJV} **Matthew 5:34** But I say unto you, Swear not at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne:
- ^{TBT} **Matthew 5:34** ἐγὼ δὲ λέγω ὑμῖν μὴ ὁμόσαι ὅλως· μήτε ἐν τῷ οὐρανῷ, ὅτι θρόνος ἐστὶ τοῦ Θεοῦ·

SECOND OCCURRENCE

- ◉ ^{KJV} **Matthew 19:28** And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the **regeneration** when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

REGENERATION (2 XS)

- ⦿ (πάλιν and γένεσις), properly, *new birth, reproduction, renewal, recreation*

- ⊙ ^{KJV} **Titus 3:5** **Not by works** of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of **regeneration**, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- ⊙ ^{TBT} **Titus 3:5** οὐκ ἐξ ἔργων τῶν ἐν δικαιοσύνῃ ὧν ἐποιήσαμεν ἡμεῖς, ἀλλὰ κατὰ τὸν αὐτοῦ ἔλεον ἔσωσεν ἡμᾶς, διὰ λουτροῦ **παλιγγενεσίας** καὶ ἀνακαινώσεως Πνεύματος Ἁγίου,

- ◉ KJV Revelation 21:14 And the wall of the city had **twelve foundations**, and in them the names of **the twelve apostles** of the Lamb.

THE GREEK WORD FOR 'SEAL'

[Thayer] σφραγίς

σφραγίς, σφραγιῶδος, ἡ (akin, apparently, to the verb φράσσω or φράγνυμι), from Herodotus down, the Septuagint for σφραγίς, *a seal*; i. e. a. *the seal placed upon books* (cf. B. D., under the word Writing, under the end; Gardthausen, *Palaeogr.*, p. 27): Rev. 5:1; λῦσαι τὰς σφραγας, *ibid.* 2, 5 (Rec.); ἀνοῖξαι, *ibid.* (5 G L T Tr WH), 9; 6:1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 12; 8:1. b. *a signet-ring*: Rev. 7:2. c. *the inscription or impression made by a seal*: Rev. 9:4 (the name of God and Christ stamped upon their foreheads must be meant here, as is evident from 14:1); 2 Tim. 2:19. d. *that by which anything is confirmed, proved, authenticated, as by a seal* (a token or proof): Rom. 4:11; 1 Cor. 9:2. (Cf. BB. DD. under the word Seal.)*

THE SEALS

- ◉ KJV Revelation 5:1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.
- ◉ KJV Revelation 5:2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
- ◉ KJV Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
- ◉ KJV Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
- ◉ KJV Revelation 6:1 And I saw when the Lamb opened **one of the seals**, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.
- ◉ KJV Revelation 6:3 And when he had opened the **second seal**, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

THE SEALS (CONT)

- KJV Revelation 6:5 And when he had opened the **third seal**, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.
- KJV Revelation 6:7 And when he had opened the **fourth seal**, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.
- KJV Revelation 6:9 And when he had opened the **fifth seal**, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:
- KJV Revelation 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the **sixth seal**, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;
- KJV Revelation 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
- KJV Revelation 8:1 And when he had opened **the seventh seal**, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.
- KJV Revelation 9:4 And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.

- ◉ Seven seals (sphragis) σφραγίς, σφραγιῶδες, ἡ
- ◉ Seven trumpets (salpinx) σάλπιγξ, σάλπιγγος, ἡ
- ◉ Seven vials or bowls (fiale) φιάλη, φιαλης, ἡ


