MEASURING WITH THE ROD

God claiming what is His own for protection and preservation

- ⦿ But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty *and* two months.¹
(Rev 11:2 KJV)

42 months=3 1/2 years

ZEC. 2:2FF

- ◉ 2 Then said I, Whither goest thou? And he said unto me, To measure Jerusalem, to see what is the breadth thereof, and what is the length thereof.
- ◉ 3 And, behold, the angel that talked with me went forth, and another angel went out to meet him,
- ◉ 4 And said unto him, Run, speak to this young man, saying, Jerusalem shall be inhabited as towns without walls for the multitude of men and cattle therein:
- ◉ 5 For I, saith the LORD, will be unto her a wall of fire round about, and will be the glory in the midst of her. (Zec 2:2-5 KJV)

- ◉ **KJV Revelation 11:1** And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure **the temple** of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein. ² **But the court** which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty *and* two months.¹

TAKE AWAY

- ◉ There will be a place of preservation for Israel.
- ◉ The temple (naos) typifies this.
- ◉ 144,000 Male Jews preserved and sealed
- ◉ **He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty Ps. 91: 1**
- ◉
to enquire in His temple. For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion:
in the secret of His tabernacle shall He hide me; He shall set me up upon a rock Ps. 27: 4, 5.
- ◉ **Thou shalt hide them in the secret of Thy presence from the pride of man: Thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues Ps. 31: 20**

TWO WITNESSES

1260 days = 42 month X 30 days/month

KJV Luke 21:24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.

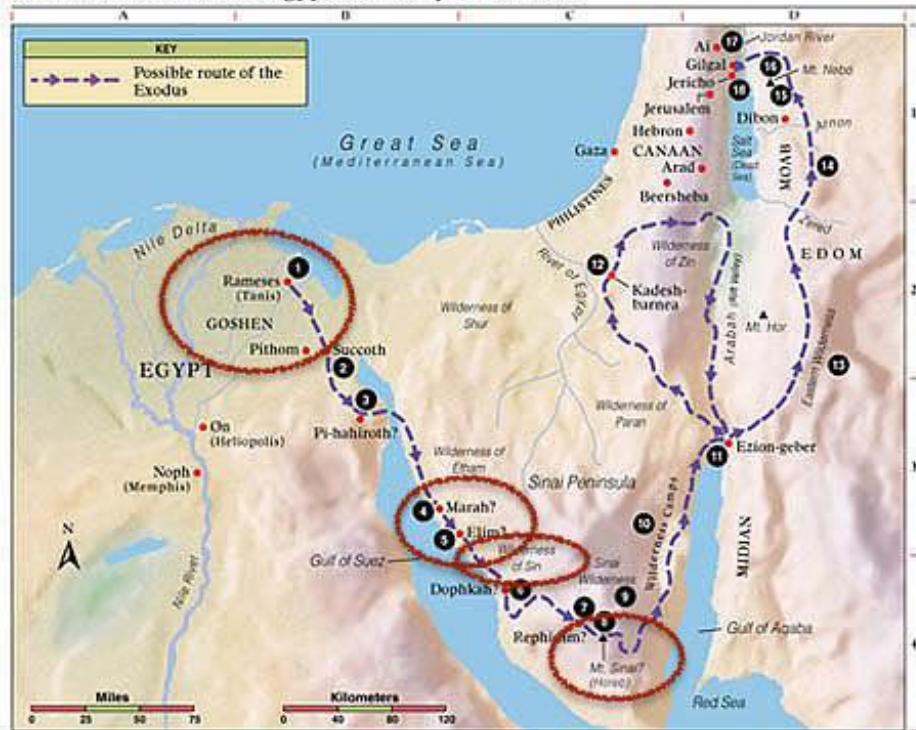
TWO WITNESSES

- ◉ KJV James 5:17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.¹ (Jam 5:17 KJV)
- ◉ ^{KJV} **Luke 4:25** But I tell you of a truth, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land; (Luk 4:25 KJV)

TWO WITNESSES

- ◉ Enoch and Elijah (Supposedly did not die Heb 11:5,13, 1Tim. 6:16, John 3:13)
- ◉ Moses and Elijah (Transfiguration)
- ◉ ^{KJV} **Matthew 17:2** And was **transfigured** before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.
- ◉ ^{TBT} **Matthew 17:2** καὶ **μετεμορφώθη** ἔμπροσθεν αὐτῶν, καὶ ἔλαμψε τὸ πρόσωπον αὐτοῦ ὡς ὁ ἥλιος, τὰ δὲ ἱμάτια αὐτοῦ ἐγένετο λευκὰ ὡς τὸ φῶς.

THE SPIRIT OF LIFE

- KJV Job 33:4 The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.
- KJV Proverbs 15:4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.
- KJV Ecclesiastes 2:17 Therefore I hated life; because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: for all is vanity and vexation of spirit.
- KJV Isaiah 38:16 O Lord, by these things men live, and in all these things is the life of my spirit: so wilt thou recover me, and make me to live.
- KJV Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- KJV Romans 8:10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
- KJV 2 Corinthians 3:6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.
- KJV Galatians 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.
- KJV Revelation 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- KJV Revelation 11:11 And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.
- KJV Revelation 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

TREE OF LIFE

- ◉ KJV Deuteronomy 20:19 When thou shalt besiege a city a long time, in making war against it to take it, thou shalt not destroy the trees thereof by forcing an axe against them: for thou mayest eat of them, and thou shalt not cut them down (for the tree of the field *is* man's *life*) to employ *them* in the siege:
- ◉ KJV Proverbs 3:18 She *is* a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy *is every one* that retaineth her.
- ◉ KJV Proverbs 11:30 The fruit of the righteous *is* a tree of life; and he that winneth souls *is* wise.
- ◉ KJV Proverbs 13:12 Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but *when* the desire cometh, *it is* a tree of life.
- ◉ KJV Proverbs 15:4 A wholesome tongue *is* a tree of life: but perverseness therein *is* a breach in the spirit.
- ◉ KJV Revelation 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- ◉ KJV Revelation 22:2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, *was there* the tree of life, which bare twelve *manner of* fruits, *and* yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree *were* for the healing of the nations.
- ◉ KJV Revelation 22:14 Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

ISA 38:18,19

○ ^{KJV} **Isaiah 38:18,19** For the grave cannot praise thee, death can *not* celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy truth.

¹⁹ The living, the living, he shall praise thee, as I *do* this day: the father to the children shall make known thy truth.

PSALMS - WHAT WAS THEIR HOPE?

- ⦿ PSALM 115:17 The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence. (Psa 115:17 KJV)
- ⦿ PSALM 146:⁴His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.
- ⦿ ⁵ Happy *is he* that *hath* the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope *is* in the LORD his God: (Psa 146:4-5 KJV)

JOB 14:11-14

- ¹¹ As the waters fail from the sea, and the flood decayeth and drieth up:
- ¹² So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens *be* no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.
- ¹³ O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me!
- ¹⁴ If a man die, shall he live *again*? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.
- (Job 14:11-14 KJV)

- ◉ KJV 2 Corinthians 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.
- ◉ 2 For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:
- ◉ 3 If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked. (2Co 5:1-3 KJV)
