- 1. “Profound significance of human choice, and the sublime responsibility of men”
 - Not trends but “choices”
 - This can sometimes mean “war”!
- 2. The limits of war and all human action.
 - Absolute stands are justified when they are absolutely necessary
 - Churchill was cautious and hesitant about war
- 3. Strategy must be rooted in the purposes of the nation: it aims to preserve the nation in pursuit of those purposes.

First occurrence of “new” νέος

- Matthew 9:17 Neither do men put new <3501> wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new <3501> wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

Is NORTHSIDE a NEW COVENANT CHURCH?

- Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

New things are not all for us

- Hebrews 8:8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant **with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:**
- Hebrews 8:13 In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old *is* ready to vanish away.
- Hebrews 12:24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than *that of Abel*.

Διαθήκη Covenant, Testament

- Romans 9:4 Who are Israelites; to whom *pertaineth* the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants <1242>, and the giving of the law, and the service *of God*, and the promises;
- 2 Corinthians 3:6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament <1242>; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.



All things are become “new” καινός

- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Revelation 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.
