

The Passion of Christ

According to the scriptures, thirty-six distinct prophecies were fulfilled in one day when Christ was taken prisoner and crucified on the cross. This 24 hour period includes the last twelve hours of Jesus which has been portrayed in the movie "[The Passion of Christ](#)". We are reminded in Acts 1:1-3 of the passion and the more important fact that He rose again.

*"The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen: To whom also **he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs**, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:"*

The "Passion of Christ" movie is a very powerful rendition of the last twelve hours of Jesus earthly ministry. The suffering from the scourging in the movie is horrible to watch. It adds a certain emphasis to the scriptures that ask us to suffer on behalf of Christ.

Phil 1:29

29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but **also to suffer for his sake**;

1 Tim 4:8-16

8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

9 This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptation.

10 For therefore **we both labour and suffer reproach**, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.

11 These things command and teach.

12 Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

14 Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery.

15 Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.

16 Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.

2 Tim 2:11-13

11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him:

12 **If we suffer, we shall also reign with him**: if we deny him, he also will deny us:

13 If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

The following table identifies the 36 Old Testament prophecies that were fulfilled in one day. It's statistically quite incredible for so many prophecies to be fulfilled in one day and therefore serves as a testimony to the providence of God. Well said the centurion in Matt 27:54 *"Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, **Truly this was the Son of God.**"*

10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

1 Tim 2:1-6

1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

4 Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

5 **For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;**

6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.
