- ▶ 44 But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many.

The Most Commonly Read Books of the Founding Generation

The Founding Fathers of the American Constitution made it clear what authors and texts had influenced their own thinking on the idea of liberty. Goodrich Seminar Room list and a few more besides. Lutz's "top 40" texts (actually 37) by frequency of citation by the founding generation are listed below.

Another source of information about what books influenced the thinking of the American founding generation are the lists of recommended books they themselves drew up. Both John Adams and Thomas Jefferson drew up a list of key texts in letters they wrote and, in the case of Jefferson, he actually donated his personal library (twice) to Congress to create the beginnings of what is now the Library of Congress and also drew up a catalog for the University of Virginia library.

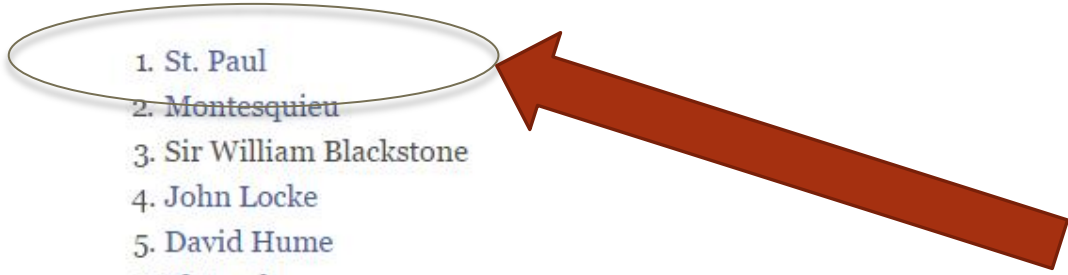

Mysteries of Revelation

- ▶ KJV Revelation 1:20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.
- ▶ KJV Revelation 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.
- ▶ KJV Revelation 17:5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

The Mystery of God = Christ

- ▶ God knows the future
- ▶ God could control every aspect of the future by programming man
- ▶ Man was made as a free agent
- ▶ God controls the times and the seasons.
- ▶ How can God control the times and the seasons while maintaining man's right to choose?
- ▶ Answer: God allows man to rebel against his will and through His secret purposes brings to pass other aspects of His will
- ▶ Prophecy is fulfilled or delayed – when delayed “mystery” is invoked

Elijah and John the Baptist

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Malachi 3:1** Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts. (Mal 3:1 KJV)

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Malachi 4:5** Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

John the Baptist

- ^{KJV} **Matthew 11:12** And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.¹
- ^{TBT} **Matthew 11:12** ἀπὸ δὲ τῶν ἡμερῶν Ἰωάννου τοῦ βαπτιστοῦ ἕως ἄρτι ἡ βασιλεία τῶν οὐρανῶν βιάζεται, καὶ βιασταὶ ἄρπάξουσιν αὐτήν.



John the Baptist

- ▶ ^{KJV} **Matthew 11:13** For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John.
- ▶ ^{TBT} **Matthew 11:13** πάντες γὰρ οἱ προφῆται καὶ ὁ νόμος ἕως Ἰωάννου προεφήτευσαν·





John the Baptist

- ^{KJV} **Matthew 11:14** And if ye will receive *it*, this is Elias, which was for to come.
- ^{TBT} **Matthew 11:14** καὶ εἰ θέλετε δέξασθαι, αὐτός ἐστιν Ἴλίας ὁ μέλλων ἔρχεσθαι.

John the Baptist

- KJV John 1:21 And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No.1
- TBT John 1:21 καὶ ἠρώτησαν αὐτόν, Τί οὖν; Ἡλίας εἶ σύ; καὶ λέγει, Οὐκ εἰμί. Ὁ προφήτης εἶ σύ; καὶ ἀπεκρίθη, Οὐ.

- ▶ KJV Isaiah 40:3 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.
 - ▶ (Isa 40:3 KJV)
 - ▶ ³ For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.
 - ▶ ⁴ And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.
 - ▶ ⁵ Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,
 - ▶ ⁶ And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.
