




Dr. Leighton Flowers, Director of Apologetics and Youth Evangelism for Texas Baptists

Named after John Calvin, "[Calvinism](#)" attempts to explain, among other things, why one person accepts Christ while another rejects Him. To the adherent, Calvinism is virtually the Gospel itself, and thus becomes one of the most important teachings in all of the Bible, if not *the* most important one. Calvinism is perhaps the central theme of what is known as "Reformed Theology." Two prominent denominations of Calvinism include [Presbyterians](#) and [Lutherans](#).

The promises -- plural

In the face of the defection of Israel –
the word of God is still effectual – how?

➤ ^{KJV} **Romans 9:6** Not as though the word of God hath taken none effect. **For they are not all Israel, which are of Israel:**

➤ ^{TBT} **Romans 9:6** οὐχ οἷον δὲ ὅτι ἐκπέπτωκεν ὁ λόγος τοῦ Θεοῦ. **οὐ γὰρ πάντες οἱ ἐξ Ἰσραήλ, οὗτοι Ἰσραήλ·**



Not all Israel which come from Israel (according to the flesh)

- ▶ Some are NOT chosen to be vessels to implement the purpose of God in relation to Israel.
 - ▶ Not every descendent of Israel was chosen to be in the lineage of Christ.
 - ▶ Not every descendent of Israel was chosen to be a prophet or messenger.

➤ ^{KJV} **Romans 9:7** Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, *are they* all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

➤ ^{TBT} **Romans 9:7** οὐδ' ὅτι εἰσὶ σπέρμα Ἀβραάμ, πάντες τέκνα · ἀλλ' Ἐν Ἰσαὰκ κληθήσεταιί σοι σπέρμα.



Allegory – Two Covenants

- **KJV Galatians 4:21** Tell me, ye that desire to be under the law, do ye not hear the law? ²² For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. ²³ But he *who* was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. ²⁴ Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar.¹ ²⁵ For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children.¹ (Gal 4:21 KJV)



➤ ^{KJV} **Romans 9:8** That is, They which are the children of the flesh, these *are* not the children of God: but the children of the promise are counted for the seed.

Seed in Romans



- KJV Romans 1:3 Concerning his Son **Jesus Christ our Lord**, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;
- KJV Romans 4:13 For the promise, **that he should be the heir of the world**, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.
- KJV Romans 4:16 Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; **who is the father of us all**,
- KJV Romans 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become **the father of many nations**, according to that which was spoken, **So shall thy seed be**.
- KJV Romans 9:7 Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, are they **all** children: **but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called**.
- KJV Romans 9:8 That is, They which are the **children of the flesh**, these are not the children of **God**: but the children of the promise are counted for the seed.
- KJV Romans 9:29 And as Esaias said before, **Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed**, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha.

“Hate”

- ^{KJV} **Matthew 6:24** No man can serve two masters: for either **he will hate the one**, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
