

### Forbearing spirit

#### Proverbs 17

- 1 Better is a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than an house full of sacrifices with strife.1
- 2 A wise servant shall have rule over a son that causeth shame, and shall have part of the inheritance among the brethren.
- 3 The fining pot is for silver, and the furnace for gold: but the LORD trieth the hearts.
- 4 A wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; and a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue. (Prov. 17:1-4 KJV)

### "Maker" in KJV

KJV Proverbs 14:31 He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor. (Prov. 14:31 KJV)

KJV Proverbs 17:5 Whoso mocketh the poor reproacheth his Maker: and he that is glad at calamities shall not be unpunished.1 (Prov. 17:5 KJV)

KJV Proverbs 22:2 The rich and poor meet together: the LORD is the maker of them all. (Prov. 22:2 KJV)

### Gift (Used to bribe): Prospereth = "sparkles"

- KJV Prov. 17:8 A gift is as a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever
  it turneth, it prospereth.
- KJV Prov. 17:23 A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.
- KJV Prov. 18:16 A man's gift maketh room for him, and bringeth him before great men.
- KJV Prov. 21:14 A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.
- KJV Prov. 25:14 Whoso boasteth himself of a false gift is like clouds and wind without rain.


### The heart to be vented

3 When the wicked cometh, then cometh also contempt, and with ignominy reproach. (Prov. 18:2-3 KJV)








### Contention, talebearer are as wounds

- 6 A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes.
- 7 A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul.
- 8 The words of a talebearer are as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly.1
- v. 18:6-8 KJV)





### Laziness and destruction

- 9 He also that is slothful in his work is brother to him that is a great waster.
- 10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.1
- 11 The rich man's wealth is his strong city, and as an high wall in his own conceit.
- 12 Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, and before honour is humility.
- 13 He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, it is folly and shame unto him (Prov. 18:9-13 KJV)



### 2 Cor 12:9

- 14 The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded spirit who can bear?
- 15 The heart of the prudent getteth knowledge; and the ear of the wise seeketh knowledge.
- 16 A man's gift maketh room for him, and bringeth him before great men.
- 17 He that is first in his own cause seemeth just; but his neighbour cometh and searcheth him.
- 18 The lot causeth contentions to cease, and parteth between the mighty.
- 19 A brother offended is harder to be won than a strong city: and their contentions are like the bars of a castle.
- 20 A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled.
- 21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. (Prov. 18:14-21 KJV)

# Wife, good thing

- 22 Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.
- 23 The poor useth intreaties; but the rich answereth roughly.
- 24 A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother. (Prov. 18:22-24 KJV)
